Dear Parents,

As we near the end of the 2019-2020 school year we would like to commend all of our students and their families for excelling during such trying times! It has truly been an honor to be working with such a resilient community and we all look forward to the return of "normalcy", whenever that may be. As part of our year end completion process, we are asking that all students issued devices be returned to the school on either May 28th or May 29th, depending on the grade level of your student. Drop off times are as follows:

- 6th Grade students: May 28th from 8am to 11am.
 - 7th Grade students: May 28th from 12pm to 3pm.
- 8th Grade students: May 29th from 8am to 11am.

Parents can drop off devices by entering the parent drop off loop as they normally would. Staff will be stationed to collect devices, hand out 3rd qtr student honor roll certificates, spring pictures (If ordered) and athletic pictures (If ordered). 8th grade students will also receive their promotion certificates and class T-shirt (If ordered). If your student needs to retrieve any items from their PE locker, we ask that you park and have your student walk to the gym to do so. Staff will be on hand to assist and only one student will be allowed into the locker room at any one time. Band instruments will also be collected during this process.

Important: Please remain in your vehicles. Please create a sign to place in the front windshield so we know your child's name so we can make sure to collect the appropriate items to place back in your trunk. We ask that all devices and power chords be placed into a bag that is clearly marked with the student's name and student number on it. Please place the devices in the trunk of your car so staff can easily remove the items while maintaining social distancing. Band instruments can be returned in this fashion as well, assuming they'll fit in the trunk.
