By the end of the 2025-26 school year, 75% of students will demonstrate Learning Gains on the ELA and MATH FAST PM3 Assessment from the 2024-25 PM3 Assessment through benchmark-aligned Tier I Instruction, targeted interventions/supports, and regular progress monitoring.

By the end of the 2025-26 school year, 44% of African American Students, Hispanic Students, ELL Students, Students with Disabilities Students, and Economically Disadvantaged Students will achieve proficiency on the FAST PM3 Assessment through benchmark-aligned Tier I Instruction, targeted interventions/supports, and regular progress monitoring.

By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, increase student access to acceleration opportunities by:

- Expanding community awareness of dual enrollment pathways and Pasco eSchool electives
- Implementing the district's new math progression plan aimed at increasing the number of 8thgrade students taking Algebra this year, with a goal of achieving a 90% pass rate on the Algebra I EOC.
- Increase opportunities for students not on the accelerated math path to take courses that offer industry certifications.
